

**Proposed FY2016-2017 FTA 5311 (Rural) and
5307 (Urban) Mass Transportation Program Applications**

Spartanburg County

PUBLIC NOTICE

The public is hereby notified of an opportunity to attend a public hearing on the proposed FY2016 – 2017 FTA Section 5311 (Rural) and 5307 (Urban) Mass Transportation Program Applications. These grant applications may be inspected at Spartanburg County Planning, 366 N Church Street Suite 700, from 9AM until 5PM weekdays. Written comments and/or requests for public hearing on these applications should be directed to Kelley Shippey Gilbert, Senior Planner at the above address prior to June 15, 2016. If a public hearing is requested, it will be held on June 20, 2016.

The FTA 5311 and 5307 Mass Transportation Programs provide assistance for transportation options and services. In Spartanburg County, SC (FTA Region IV), these services are provided on behalf of Spartanburg County by Spartanburg Regional Health Services District using ADA compliant cutaway vehicles. The City of Spartanburg also operates a separate mass transportation service known as SPARTA.

The total estimated amount requested by Spartanburg County for the period July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017 is as follows:

For the 5307 (Urban) program, we are requesting a total of \$2,930,000 (\$1,803,000 Federal, \$143,137 State and the balance from local sources). For the 5311 (Rural) program, we are requesting a total of \$1,178,019 (\$491,989 Federal, \$138,667 State and the balance from local sources). This reflects amounts budgeted for program administration, operations, planning/technical assistance and capital costs.
