

WADSWORTH TRAIL MULTI-USE PATH



Description: This trail is located on the Westside of Spartanburg alongside Willis Road. It is a mostly flat, paved wide path that can be used by non-motorized vehicles or pedestrians. The trail is the result of a coordinated effort by many organizations including and sparked by the Westside Neighborhood Association. There are not many street lights, so the trail is best-used in the daytime.

Length: 2.2 miles or 3.6 kilometers paved

Fees: No fees

Directions: From the City of Spartanburg, head south on US 29. Pass under the I-26 interchange, continue through the light at McDonald's, take a left at the next light- South Blackstock Rd. Stay in the left lane. Go to the end of the block and take a right on Willis Road. About 1/4 mile up on the left is the Westside Club. Park there. Trail is visible closer to the road.

Hours: All hours. It is best to use the path during the daylight hours for more security. Please be respectful of the many residences in the vicinity.
