

CASE STUDY: RAIL TRAIL- SPARTANBURG TO LANDRUM

OVERVIEW

A portion of the Palmetto Trail in Spartanburg County could link the City of Spartanburg with the Towns of Inman, Campobello, and Landrum as well as several destinations along the route utilizing an existing rail road corridor.

CONNECTIONS

- City of Spartanburg with the Town of Landrum
- Possible North Carolina/South Carolina link
- Parks
- Schools
- Lake Bowen
- Existing sidewalk/bicycle/greenway networks

IMPLEMENTATION

- Approximately 37 miles of trail with 10 foot minimum width
- Corridor Plan/Design with Constuction Documents following
- Easement/Land acquisition
- Necessary State, County, and City permitting
- Curb ramps, crosswalks, and signage at all roadway intersections
- Intersection enhancements at all signalized intersections

COST ESTIMATE

- Trail: \$26,000,000 (Paved surface)
- Intersection Improvements along route: \$1,000,000
